GROWING TIPS

A - annual - plant seeds in early Spring or Fall
A* - annual - these reseeding annuals will have earlier (and perhaps better) Spring germination if planted in the Fall
A** - annual - must be replanted in Spring
B - plant seeds after frost; do not cover seeds - or start indoors
C - plant seeds after frost; cover seeds lightly - or start indoors
D - soak seeds 2-4 hours before planting
E - stagger planting for extended flowering
F - these germinate/emerge late, so don't be discouraged!
G - perennial/biennial - may not bloom first year
H - reseeding annual or biennial
J - deep tap root - plant in permanent location
K - attracts butterflies and/or (humming)birds
L - grown for foliage
M - good ground cover
N - cut back in Spring for Winter interest and/or so birds can pick at seeds in Fall
O - must be lifted in Fall and stored over Winter
